The Oregon Trail School District spans 424 square miles and serves the communities of Sandy, Boring, and the Mt. Hood Area. We encompass several distinct, mostly unincorporated, rural areas of Clackamas County. Enrollment is approximately 4,300 students, K-12, with one high school, three middle schools, five elementary schools, and a K-10 IB charter school.
