

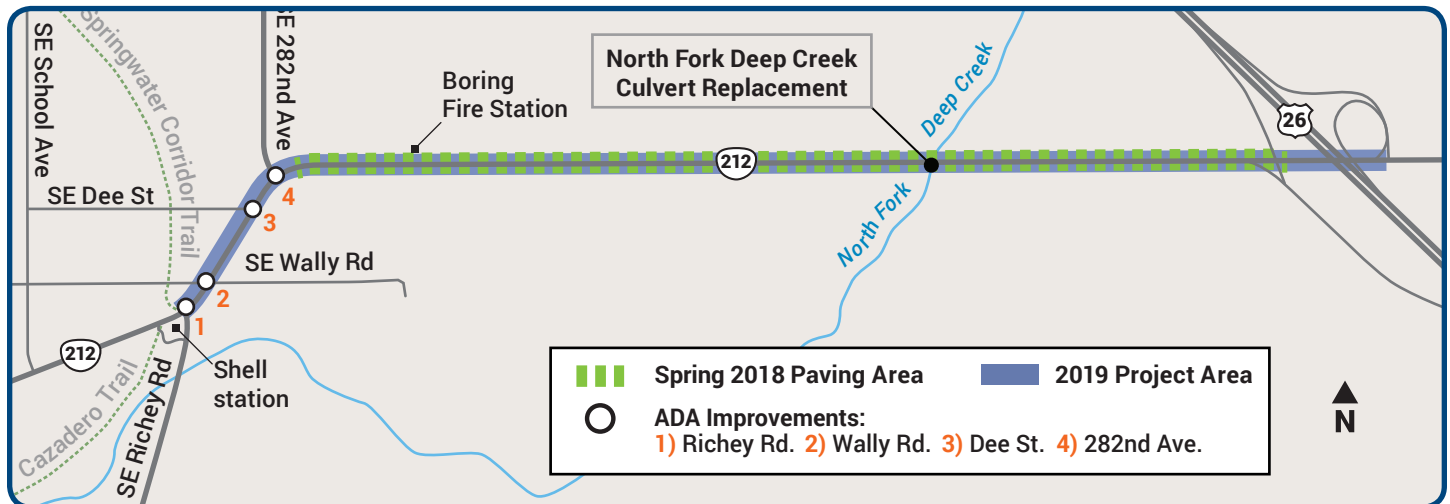
OR 212 IMPROVEMENTS SE Richey Road to U.S. 26

WINTER 2018



Improvements coming to OR 212 between SE Richey Road and U.S. 26

The pavement on Oregon 212 between SE Richey Road and U.S. 26 needs repair due to potholes and cracking. Paving last occurred in this area in 2000. Work includes short-term maintenance, as well as long-term pavement improvements.



Project Snapshot

- Rehabilitation and repaving of OR 212.
 - April 16-20, OR 212 will receive initial paving between Boring Fire Station and U.S. 26 to prepare this area for detour traffic from the SE 282nd Avenue/Boring Road Bridge Raising Project.
 - **Expect 20 minute delays on OR 212 and nearby driveways from 9 a.m. to 9 p.m. Monday, April 16 through Friday, April 20.** Paving is weather dependent and may be rescheduled due to wet weather.
 - In 2019, OR 212 will receive long-term final paving between Richey Road and just east of U.S. 26.
- ADA-compliant sidewalk curb ramps and pedestrian facilities.
Environmentally-friendly replacement culvert will accommodate North Deep Creek, currently carried under OR 212 via corrugated pipe. This work requires a 7-day closure of OR 212 at the culvert site, with a signed detour.

The closure will occur between July and September 2019 or 2020.

Anticipated schedule

- Design: now through November 2018
- Right-of-way acquisition: January 2018 – November 2018
- Construction: throughout 2019
